## **Bristol Authority**

If you have immediate concerns about your own or someone else's safety, call the Police on **999**. If it isn't an emergency but you need help fast, call the Police on **101**.

If you suspect that an adult in Bristol with care and support needs is being abused of neglected but their health or welfare is not in immediate danger, contact Care Direct here. You will be directed to different forms depending on whether you are a member of the public or a professional.
